

CONCRETE CARE

DAILY CARE

It is recommended that you use a neutral cleaner to clean the concret surface. Wipe up food or other spills after they happen with a soft cloth as soon as possible especially acidic, alcohol-based or oil-based spills. Never use abrasive cleaners, acidic cleaners, oil soaps or furniture polish as these products may make the surface slick or soften the finish. Applying Original Beese Wax or a Stone refresher periodically will be spills cleanup a little easier and help prevent micro-scratches that occur with everyday use. Simply apply a light, spray coat and wait until it dries to a dull finish. Once dry, buff with a clean soft cloth. Waxing the countertop is not required to keep the countertop sealed properly but does assist with cleaning and micro scratches.

SEALERS

Crete Collective uses high performance sealers for all their products. All concrete sealers have a level of stain resistance and scratch resistance. It is important wipe up spills as soon a possible especially acidic as it can etch the sealer and avoid dragging objects across the surface. The sealers can be recoated in the Edmonton and Greater area for a fee. Reach out to Crete Collective for any further advice on refreshing the sealer.

GUIDELINES

Spills Acidic foods, beverages, or cleaners (lemon juice, mustard, vinegar, wine, soda, citric acid, tomatoes, etc.), perfumes, colognes, and other harsh chemicals/solvents (ammonia, acetone, hydrogen peroxide, etc.) should be cleaned from your concrete promptly. These substances may etch the sealer, leaving a light hazing, and possibly expose or stain your concrete	Cleaners Avoid abrasive soaps, cleansers, or scrubbing pads that can wear down the sealer. We recommend using mild, non-abrasive, non-ammonia, non-citric acid, non-vinegar, non-bleach soaps and cleaners. Recommended: Mild Soap & water Lysol All Purpose Simple Green Mr. Clean Multi-Purpose Spray
Hot Pots Concrete is very heat resistant but the concern is more about damaging the sealers protecting the concrete. So avoid placing pans and pots directly on the surface. Suggested to use trivets or a pad.	Cutting/Abrasion Avoid cutting directly on your surfaces, it can damage the sealers and your knives. Good practice is to you use a cutting board. Avoid dragging hard or sharp items across the surface. It can create micro scratches overtime and allow for stains to get past the sealers. Place felt pads on items that will be on the surface often.
Impact Concrete is extremely strong but avoid using it as a worktop or dropping heavy objects on it. Excessive force can chip the concrete. Use the products as intended purpose	Outdoor Products Best practice is to cover outdoor kitchens and tops in winter months to protect from snow and ice if possible. It will extend the life of the product and protect the sealer over time.
Moving and Installing Take care when moving larger pieces. They have reinforcement but sudden drops or twists can cause cracking. Carrying on edge is best practice. Any issues must be reported within 7 days of installation/delivery.

Hairline cracks, cracking due to high heat, surface scratches, staining, chips, improper care, failures due to inadequate support or un-level cabinetry are not included as part of this Warranty.

This warranty does not cover scratches or stains.

Chip and Sealer repairs are not covered. Crete Collective can repair these for a fee in the Edmonton and Greater Area. Or we can ship you a chip repair kit if needed.
